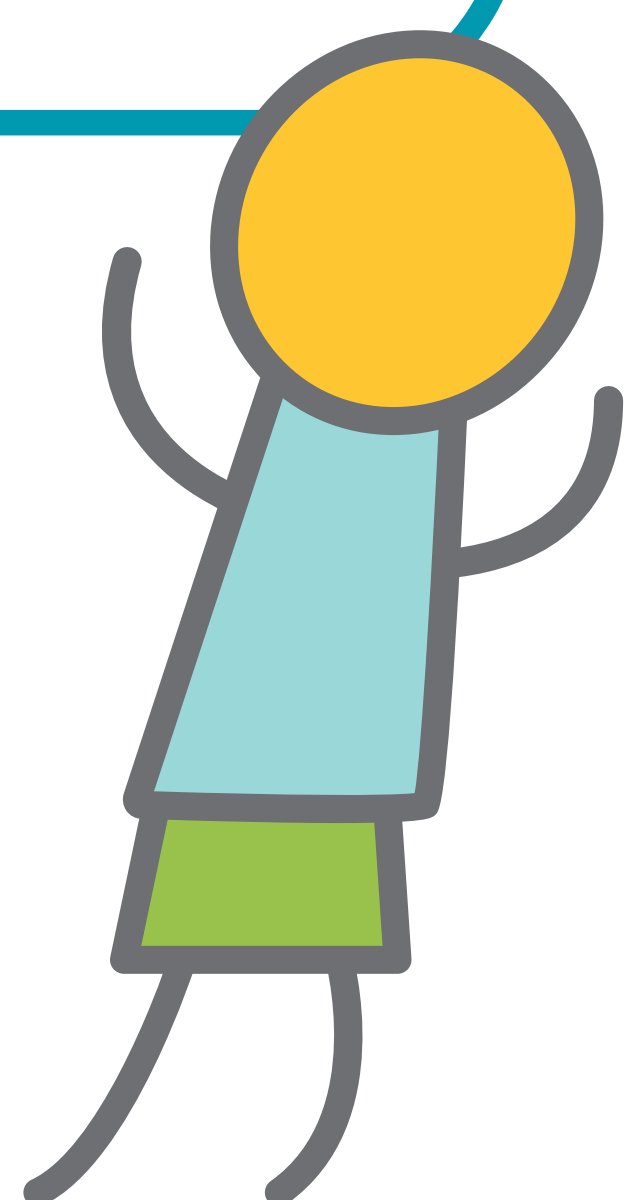

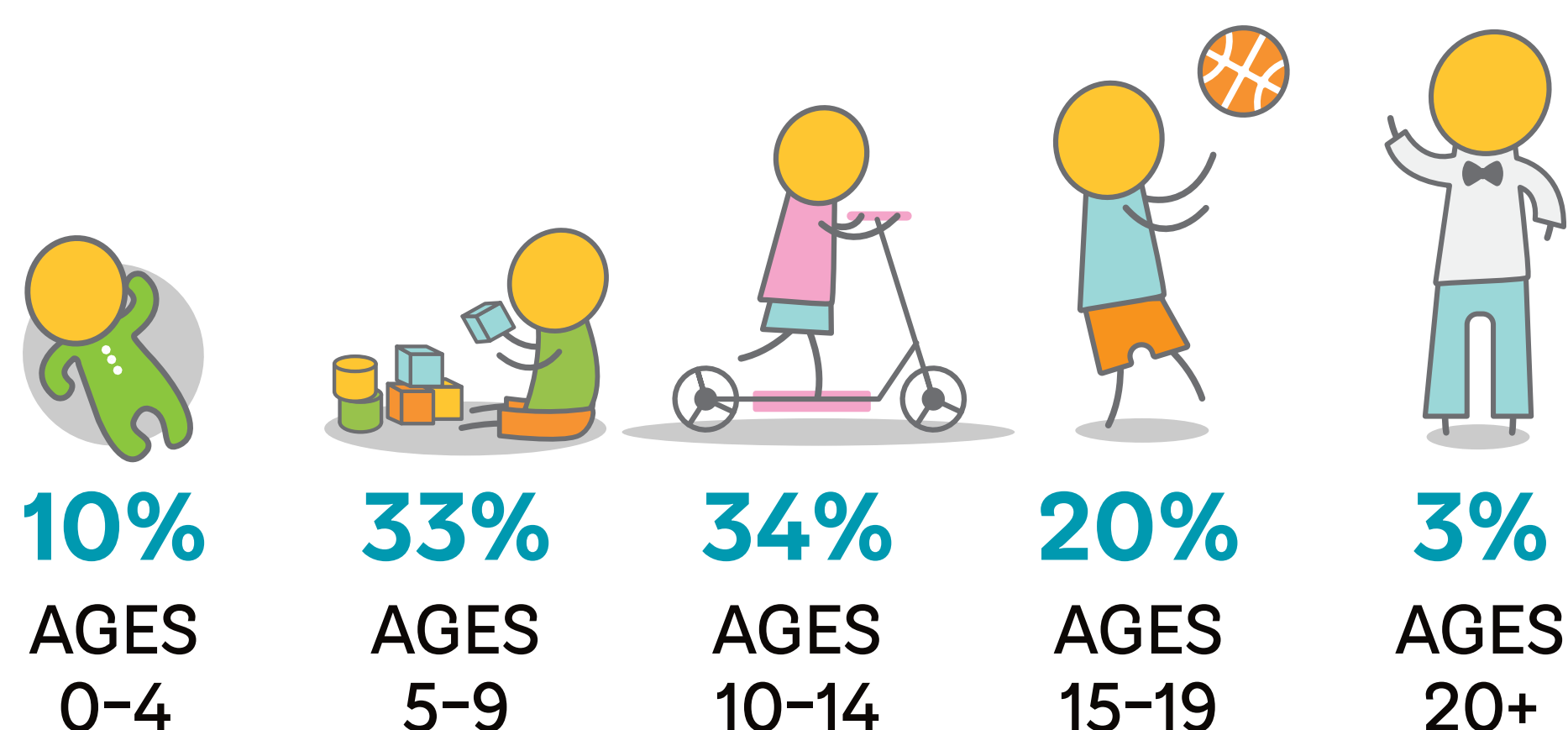

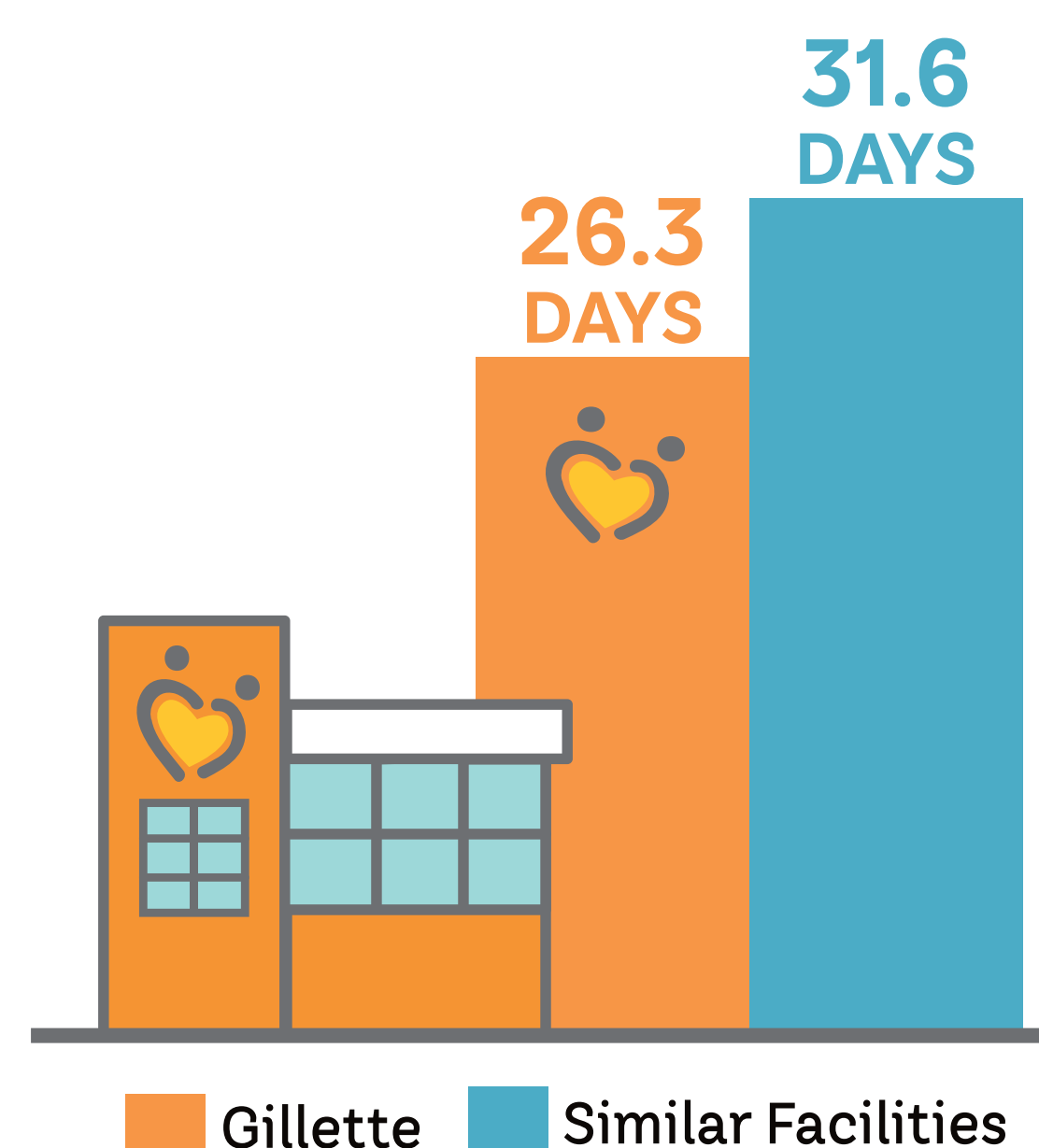
Total Rehabilitation Program Patients

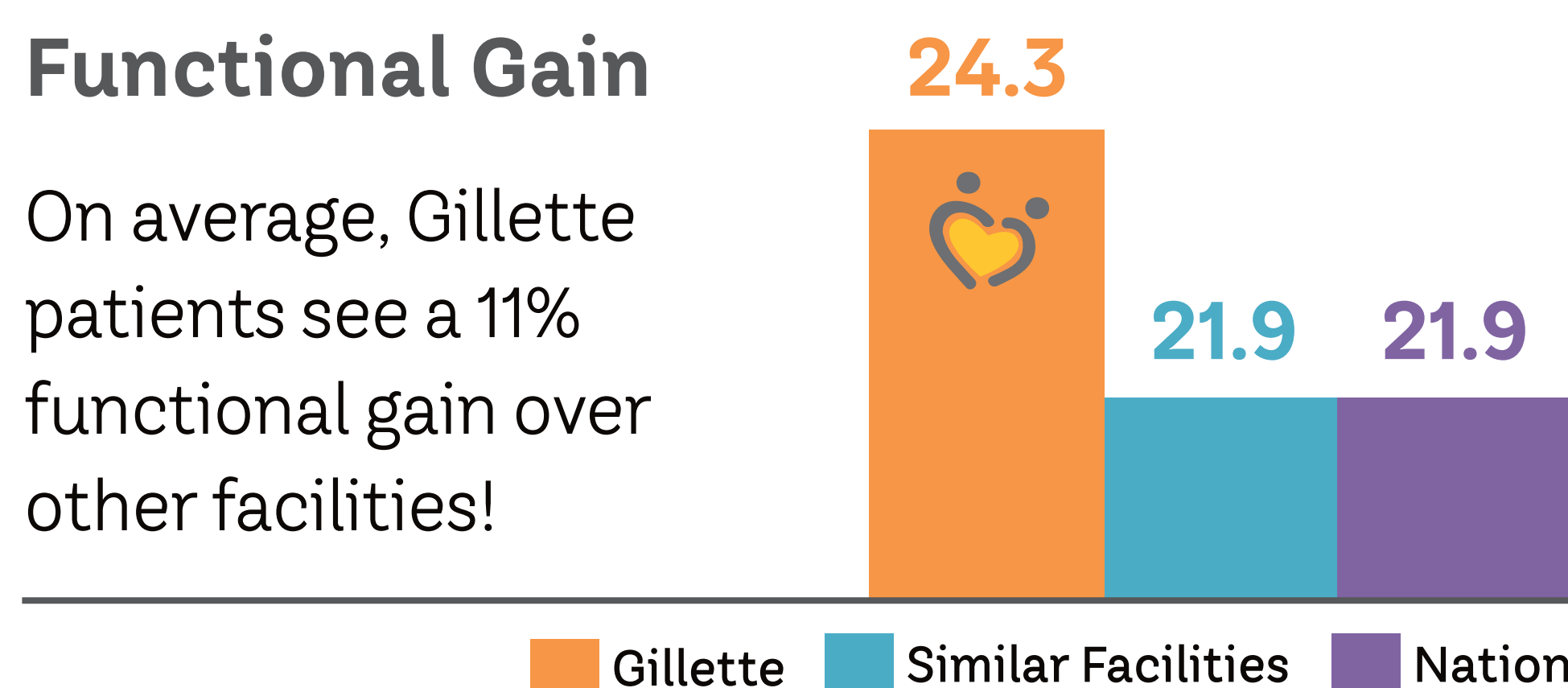
